Prerequisites

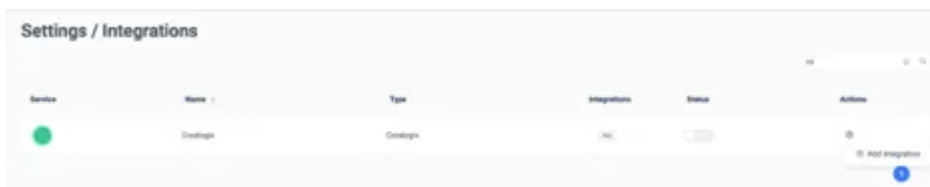
- Admin access to your SURF account

STEP 1. Navigate to the SURF [admin console](#).

STEP 2. From your toolbar, navigate to **Settings > Integrations**.

STEP 3. Search for **Coralogix** and add the integration by clicking the gear icon on the right.



STEP 4. Update the Token with your Coralogix [Send-Your-Data-API-key](#) and the URL with your Coralogix [domain](#).

STEP 5. Select all the relevant checkboxes for the data to be sent. Click **Submit**.
